Set up Timings.

- Set up – Friday 27th August 2021, 3:00pm until 8:00pm.
- Set up – Saturday 28th 7:00am until 8:30am.
- The show is open to the public, Saturday, Sunday, and Monday from 10:00 AM.
Please note that set up can only take place during the above times.

Stands

- Only printed matter appertaining to yourselves can be shown. All aisles must be kept clear of obstructions in the pavilion, railway visitor centre (Outside).
- To trade on the site, a risk assessment must be completed and returned to us.
- The main gates will be locked from 10:00 PM until 7:00 AM.
- On arrival the trader will report to the rally control.

Site Rules.

- BEC reserves the right to refuse admission should visitors breach any rules and regulations of the BEC.
- We regret that we cannot accept responsibility or liability for any loss, theft, or injury on this site under any circumstances. Except in the case of personal injuries or death caused solely by our neglect.
- BEC reserves the right to cancel any events due to unforeseen conditions, any fees will be reimbursed.
- Attendance at the show, camping/caravanning and parking is at your own risk. All visitors must comply with all safety announcements and venue regulations while attending the show.
- Please **DO NOT** light fires or barbecues.
- **DO NOT** leave valuables unattended and all vehicles must be locked at all times.
- the site speed limit is strictly 5 mph.

Camping

- On arrival, it is the responsibility of the camper to report to the rally control to agree pitching instructions.
- A camping pass is issued by the BEC and must be shown on entry to the site by each of the caravan/camping unit and displayed at all times.
- Caravans and tents must be pitched at a minimum space of six metres apart and in a position agreed with the campsite officer.

- Pitches must be kept tidy and left clean on vacating the site.
- No holes, pits, or drainage channels to be dug on the rally site without the express consent of the campsite officer.
- Properly constructed toilet tents may be erected.
- Wastewater must be collected in a suitable receptacle and disposed of at the disposal point provided.
- All rubbish must be taken home.
- vehicles must **NOT** be driven unnecessarily on the campsite.
- A speed limit of 5 mph is applicable to all vehicles on the campsite.
- Current driving licence holders **ONLY** to drive on the campsite. Learner and unlicensed drivers are **NOT** permitted to drive on the site.
- Motorcycles and mopeds are not permitted to drive on the campsite.
- Open fires must **NOT** be lit on the campsite.
- Barbecues must only be lit and used at the designated barbecue area.
- It is highly recommended that each caravan, tent or camping unit is equipped with a fire extinguisher and everyone knows how to operate such equipment.
- All campers should acquaint themselves with the location of fire points/fire extinguishers.
- Dogs must be kept under control and on a lead not exceeding 3 metres when on any part of the campsite.
- Dogs must not be allowed to foul on the campsite, dog walkers are requested to clear up after their animals and dispose of the waste in a sealed bag at the refuse disposal point provided.
- Noise from musical instruments, radios, television, or other entertainment equipment must not inconvenience others.
- Generators must be adequately silenced and not caught annoying to other people.
- Generators should not be run between the hours of 11.00pm and 8:00am without the express permission of the campsite officer.
- Generators must comply with and be operated to all current British Standards and HSE requirements.
- The flying of model aircraft or kites is not permitted.
- Ball games are not permitted close to the caravans, tents or rally field.
- Catapults, air con or other firearms are not permitted on the campsite.
- The campsite officer is responsible for the general conduct of the site and has the authority to require people to leave the campsite for any contravention and of the foregoing rules.

A Health & Safety code is in force for yourself and the general public
